- □ Must be on 11"X17" poster board or heavy-weight paper
- □ May be horizontal or vertical
- □ Should be appropriate to the subject, purpose, and theme of the contest
- □ Will be scored according to the attached rubric guidelines
- Entry form must be attached to the back of the poster and signed by student

Essays and Poems:

- □ Must be typed
- □ Must be double-spaced
- □ Must use 12 point, Times New Roman font
- □ Must NOT exceed 400 words
- Will be scored according to the attached rubric guidelines
- Entry form must be attached to the back of the poster and signed by student
